Duties: Essential Functions: As the technical specialist, write complex programs and detailed program specifications and system documentation applying knowledge, experience, and expertise of Java EE; PHP; Javascript, HTML, CSS, XML; Windows and Windows Server; Oracle; Glass Fish; NetBeans IDE; Oracle SQL Developer to to maintain and support the REALE system and the online renewal and search systems for the licensing, enforcement, education, history, accounting, interfaces and batches for the BRE systems.

Perform complex analysis, design, coding, bug fixes and enhancements on existing or new systems. Conduct all levels of testing to the BRE in-house REALE system and the online renewal and search systems. Create documentation of all changes and test results. Follow all processes/steps of the systems development life cycle.

Independently assess data structure, analyze operational methods, understand requirements, identify process to apply changes and develop programs to meet desired results. Apply principles and techniques of studying work processes for new or revised technology systems applications and designing methods of processing information. Ensure the overall system functionality works as identified in task requirements.

Develop and maintain a project plan using Teamforge. Perform project tasks and provide project deliverables as outlined in the plan. Create goals that address BRE criteria for task assignment and completion. Follow State IT policies and procedures as they relate to project management.

Communicate and interact with staff. Attend meetings with development team and management. Prepare and provide effective reports, spreadsheets and presentations using Microsoft Office Professional Suite 2010. Work effectively with all levels of technical staff and management; mentor and motivate the IT team for technical challenges; and deliver high quality customer service.

The incumbent may be required to work after hours and/or be placed on stand by/call back status after their normal work hours.
